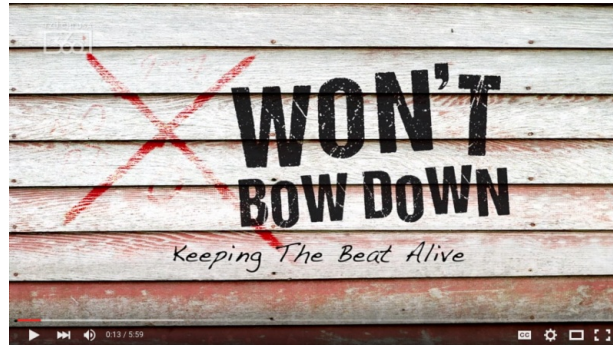


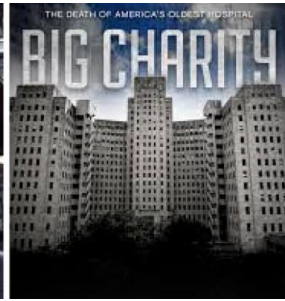


## New video about the NOMC
