now through December 15th!**

November 1st marked the beginning of Open Enrollment. Like in 2018, you will notice a shorter enrollment period than years past. The time to act is now!



Think you can't afford health insurance? Think again! In Louisiana, approximately 90% of residents qualify for financial assistance to help pay for costs associated with their insurance plan. Some may qualify for free or low-cost coverage through Medicaid. [Enroll today!](#)

Marketplace plans cover a comprehensive set of benefits, including physician visits, preventive care, hospital stays, and prescriptions. Discrimination based on gender or preexisting conditions is no longer allowed, making it easier to get covered.

## Key Enrollment Dates

- The 2019 Open Enrollment Period runs from **Thursday, November 1 - Saturday, December 15, 2018**.
- If you don't act by **December 15, 2018**, you can't get 2019 coverage unless you qualify for a special enrollment period.
- Plans sold during open enrollment start **January 1, 2019**.

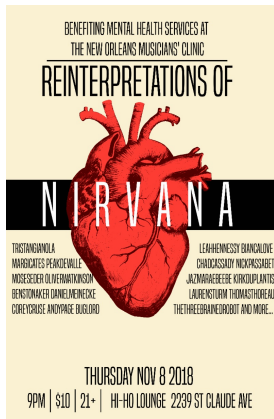
## [New Orleans Public Library](#)
