# Louisiana 2018\*





On average, one person dies by suicide every 13 hours in the state.

# Nearly four times as many people in Louisiana die by suicide than by HIV.

The total deaths to suicide reflect a total of 14,429 years of potential life lost (YPLL) before age 65.



Suicide cost Louisiana a total of \$675,990,000 of combined lifetime medical and work loss cost in 2010, or an average of \$1,213,626 per suicide death.
